The Government of Liberia has signed financing agreements for Grants/Concessionary loans from three donor partners including the Government of Norway, the European Investment Bank, and KFW Development Bank for the rehabilitation of the 60-80 MW hydropower generating plant at Mount Coffee, in Liberia.

This International Invitation for Pre-Qualification relates to the contract for Operation, Maintenance and Capacity Building Services of the Mt. Coffee Power Plant. Initially the assignment requires establishment of the operation and maintenance organisation and recruitment of staff, and shall as well encompass implementation and management of operation and maintenance of the Power Plant as well as training of local employees for an agreed period of time.

Applicants shall primarily be power companies. A joint venture (consortium) between a hydro power generating company and a hydro power design consultant will also be considered. The number of participants in the consortium shall not exceed three. Within 25% of the contract budget the joint venture may also engage a sub-consultant.

The criteria to be used in the Pre-Qualification evaluation are: Experience in the successful completion of similar projects, Financial Situation, and Historical Contract performance.
